Habitat & ecology:

This species is found in the intermediate estuarine zone in the mid-intertidal region.

Population: This species is very common within its range. It can be found in densities of more than 500 trees/ha in South Sumatra with a mean diameter of 35 cm (Sukardjo 1987).

Use and Trade: This is a valuable fuelwood species. This is the preferred species for mangrove silviculture, for example in Matang, Malaysia and Sumatra, Indonesia this species commercially planted for charcoal production.

Bangladesh, Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand, southern Viet Nam, and China.
